
What is a Bird??

A warm blooded, egg laying vertebrat

Body covered with feathers

Forelimbs modified to form wings





What is birding/birdwatching??

- Observing birds
- Hearing calls/songs of birds
- Observing their colors, behavior, movements etc.





Why birding??

- Quality time spend with nature
- Keeps you Physically and mentally healthy
- Aids in conservation efforts
- Contribution to science
- Good message to our next generation





Importance of Birds

- Natural pest control helps in agriculture
- Pollination carrier
- Birds like vultures are scavengers. By feeding upon dead animals, they keep our environment clean and prevent spread of diseases
- Birds that feed upon fruits, excretes seeds which helps to grow more trees
- Maintain the balance of ecosystem




Where to go??

Best season for birding ??

- Depends on your target
- For Winter migrant birds: November February
- For Resident birds: Throughout the year
- For monitoring nesting activity: breeding season of particular species
- For autumn passage migrants: August-October



Best time for birding ??

- Early morning: best
- Evening also good
- Owls and nocturnal birds at night






What to look for ??


- Call/song

 - Primary projection


Topography of a bird


















Birding ethics

- Obey forest rules
- Don't approach nesting birds
- Avoid going in large groups






How to become a better birder ??
